I MOTION

1. <u>Motion Approving the Appointment of Mr. Douglas Singh as Chairman, Elections and Boundaries Commission, 2016.</u>

The Leader of Government Business and Minister of Home Affairs and Immigration moved:-

WHEREAS, subsection (1) of section 88 of the Constitution of Belize provides that there shall be an Elections and Boundaries Commission which shall consist of a Chairperson and four other members who shall be persons of integrity and high national standing;

AND WHEREAS, it is further provided by subsection (2) of that section that the Chairperson and two other members of the Elections and Boundaries Commission shall be appointed by the Governor-General, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister given after consultation with the Leader of the Opposition, and the remaining two members shall be appointed by the Governor-General, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister given with the concurrence of the Leader of the Opposition, provided that in the process of consultation with the Leader of the Opposition for the appointment of the Chairperson, the Prime Minister shall use his best endeavors to secure the agreement of the Leader of the Opposition;

AND WHEREAS, it is further provided by subsection (4) of that section that if any member of the Commission dies or resigns, the Governor-General shall appoint another person in his place in the same manner in which such member was appointed;

AND WHEREAS, **MR. BERNARD Q. A. PITTS, S.C., CBE**, who was appointed as Chairperson of the Elections and Boundaries Commission for a period of five (5) years on the 15th May, 2012 is now deceased;

AND WHEREAS, the Prime Minister, after due consultation with, and having used his best endeavours to secure the agreement of, the Leader of the Opposition, intends to advise the Governor General that **Mr. DOUGLAS SINGH**, be appointed

as the Chairperson of the Elections and Boundaries Commission for a period of five (5) years with effect from 1st January, 2016;

AND WHEREAS, subsections (2)(c) and (3) of section 61A of the Constitution of Belize provide that a member of the Elections and Boundaries Commission can only be validly appointed with the prior approval of the Senate;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Honourable Senate, being satisfied that **Mr. DOUGLAS SINGH** is a person of integrity and high national standing, approve his appointment as the Chairperson of the Elections and Boundaries Commission for a period of five (5) years with effect from 1st January, 2016, in accordance with the abovementioned provisions of the Constitution of Belize.

After the debate thereon, Motion was referred to the Constitution and Foreign Affairs Committee for examination, consideration and report.
