I MOTION

1. Government of the Republic of China (Taiwan) US\$25,000,000 Loan Motion, 2017.

The Leader of Government Business and Minister of Agriculture, Forestry, Fisheries, the Environment, Sustainable Development and Immigration moved:-

WHEREAS, the Government of Belize, through its bi-lateral program of economic cooperation and development with the Government of the Republic of China (Taiwan), has received an offer of further financial support from the Government of that country;

AND WHEREAS, the offer of financial support is in the form of a long-term, concessionary Loan in the principal amount of US\$25.0 million;

AND WHEREAS, the purpose of the Loan is to provide for general budgetary support;

AND WHEREAS, the terms and conditions of the Loan Offer are as follows:

Lender: Mega International

Commercial Bank Co. Ltd. of the Republic of China

(Taiwan);

Loan Principal Amount: US\$25,000,000.00;

Disbursement Schedule: To be disbursed in Advances,

within one calendar year from the signing of the

Agreement;

Loan Term: 20 years;

Grace Period: 3 years;

Repayment: In thirty-five (35)

consecutive, almost equal semi-annual principal installments commencing 36 months after the signing date

of the Agreement;

Purpose: General budgetary support;

Rate of Interest: Six-month Libor + 2.5%;

AND WHEREAS, under the provisions of section 7 (1) of the Finance and Audit (Reform) Act, 2005, the Government of Belize is required to obtain the prior authorization of the National Assembly, by way of a Resolution, for such borrowing;

NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Honorable House, being satisfied that the Loan proceeds would be utilized for the purpose stated above, approves and confirms that the Government of Belize may enter into a Loan Agreement with the Mega International Commercial Bank Co. Ltd. of the Republic of China (Taiwan) on the terms and conditions set out above, and further authorizes the Minister of Finance to execute and deliver the said Loan Agreement and all other documents and agreements connected therewith.

After the debate thereon, question put and agreed to.

4. Non-Governmental Organisations (Amendment) Bill, 2016.

Bill for an Act to amend the Non-Governmental Organisations Act, Chapter 315 of the Substantive Laws of Belize, Revised Edition 2011, to make further provision for the recognition of the status of registered Non-Governmental Organisations; and to provide for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.
