**AN ACT** to amend the Contractor-General Act, Chapter 6 of the Substantive Laws of Belize, Revised Edition 2011, to remove the restriction on the eligibility for appointment in the public service after holding office as the Contractor-General; and to provide for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.

***BE IT ENACTED***, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Representatives and Senate of Belize and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the

**CONTRACTOR-GENERAL (AMENDMENT)**

CAP. 6. and shall be read and construed as one with the Contractor-General Act, which is hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

2. The principal Act is amended by repealing section 8 and substituting the following—

“8. A person appointed as Contractor-General shall—

- (a) be a full-time officer;  
and
- (b) not be employed in any other capacity during any period in which that person holds office as Contractor-General.”.
