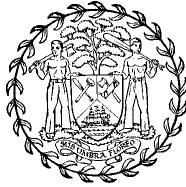

AN ACT to amend the Firearms Act, Chapter 143 of the Substantive Laws of Belize, Revised Edition 2011, to provide for new licensing fees; and to provide for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.

(Gazetted 14th December, 2019).

BE IT ENACTED, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Representatives and Senate of Belize and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the

FIREARMS (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2019,

and shall be read and construed as one with the Firearms Act, which as amended, is hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

Amendment of section 3.

2. Section 3(4) of the principal Act is amended in the Table—

- (a) in paragraph (a) by deleting “\$225.00” and “\$1,500.00” and substituting “\$75.00” and “\$500.00” respectively; and
- (b) in paragraph (i) by deleting the fees specified in the Second and Third Columns and substituting the following—

“Category A (up to 10 firearms)	\$2,000.00	\$5,000.00
Category B (11 to 20 firearms)	\$4,000.00	\$10,000.00
Category C (21 to 40 firearms)	\$8,000.00	\$20,000.00
Category D (41 to 60 firearms)	\$16,000.00	\$40,000.00”.
