I BILLS FOR SECOND READING

1. Hydro Maya Power Project Bill, 2019.

Bill for an Act to comply with and give effect to certain undertakings and obligations of the Government of Belize, under and in connection with a concession agreement for the establishment and operation of a hydroelectric generating facility in Belize; to provide for certain exemptions from taxes and duties; and to provide for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.

2. Excise (Management and Tariff) Bill, 2019.

Bill for an Act to provide for the licensing of manufacturers of excisable goods, for the control of the manufacture of excisable goods, for the imposition and collection of excise duties; and to provide for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.
