BE IT ENACTED, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Representatives and Senate of Belize and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the

and shall be read and construed as one with the Summary Jurisdiction (Offences) Act, which, as amended, is hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

Amendment of section 3.

**2.** The principal Act is amended in section 3 by inserting the following new sub-section immediately after sub-section (4)–

"(4A) Notwithstanding sub-section (4), a person who commits an offence under sub-section (1)(ix) is liable on summary conviction to a fine of three thousand dollars or to imprisonment for a term of six months."
