MOTION

1. Resolution Recommending the Appointment of a Contractor-General Motion, 2023.

Notice given on 2nd March 2023.

WHEREAS, section 3(2) of the Contractor-General Act, Chapter 6 of the Substantive Laws of Belize, Revised Edition 2020, provides that the Contractor-General shall be appointed by the Governor-General acting on the recommendations of both Houses of the National Assembly contained in resolutions passed in that behalf;

AND WHEREAS, the office of the Contractor-General has been vacant since 2^{nd} February 2023;

AND WHEREAS, sections 61A (2) (*c*) and (3) of the Belize Constitution provide that the Contractor-General can only be validly appointed with the prior approval of the Senate;

AND WHEREAS, the Senate has, on the 29th day of March 2023, approved the appointment of **MS. MARIA ARTHURS** as Contractor-General;

AND WHEREAS, MS. MARIA ARTHURS is 38 years of age (date of birth 26th July 1984) and falls within the age limit prescribed by the Contractor-General Act;

AND WHEREAS, MS. MARIA ARTHURS fulfills the requirements for appointment to the office of Contractor-General as prescribed in the Contractor-General Act;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Honourable House recommends that **MS. MARIA ARTHURS** be appointed as Contractor-General for a period of three (3) years with effect from 1st June 2023.
