Resolution Authorizing the Ratification by Belize of the Agreement Between the Government of Belize and the Government of Hungary on the Mutual Visa Exemption for Holders of Diplomatic, Service and Official Passports Motion, 2021.

WHEREAS, the Agreement between the Government of Belize and the Government of Hungary on the Mutual Visa Exemption for Holders of Diplomatic, Service, and Official Passports (hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement") was signed on 28th May 2021, in Mexico City;

AND WHEREAS, the objective of the Agreement is to permit nationals of Belize and Hungary who hold valid diplomatic, service or official passports to enter, exit and transit through the territory of the other Party without a visa requirement and stay there for a period not exceeding ninety (90) days in any one hundred and eighty (180) day period;

AND WHEREAS, the Government of Belize is desirous of ratifying the Agreement pursuant to Article 16 of the Agreement;

AND WHEREAS, section 61(A)(2)(a) of the Belize Constitution, as amended by the Belize Constitution (Sixth Amendment) Act (No.13 of 2008), provides that the Senate shall authorize the ratification of any treaty by the Government of Belize;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate authorizes the Government of Belize to ratify the Agreement between the Government of Belize and the Government of Hungary on the Mutual Visa Exemption for Holders of Diplomatic, Service and Official Passports, a full text of which is hereto annexed.
