**BELIZE CONSTITUTION (JUDICIAL AND LEGAL SERVICES) (PRESCRIBED OFFICES) ORDER, 2023**

2. In exercise of the power vested in me under section 110F(2) of the Belize Constitution and all other powers thereunto me enabling, I hereby prescribe the following offices as falling within the definition of “judicial and legal services” for the purpose of sub-section (2)–

Offices.

- (a) Chief Registrar;
- (b) Deputy Registrar of the Court of Appeal;
- (c) Assistant Registrar of the High Court;
- (d) Chief Parliamentary Counsel;
- (e) Deputy Solicitor General;
- (f) Assistant Solicitor General;

- (g) Deputy Director of Public Prosecutions;
- (h) Assistant Director of Public Prosecutions;
- (i) Director of Family Court;
- (j) Senior Magistrate;
- (k) Judicial Assistant;
- (l) Law Revision Officer;
- (m) Legal Assistant.

Commencement.

3. This Order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 15th day of November, 2022.
