**“Women’s Parliamentarian Caucus Standing
Committee**

68B. The Women’s Parliamentarian Caucus Standing Committee shall consider all matters which appears to the Committee to affect women’s rights, gender equality, and any other matter connected therewith or incidental thereto.”.
