PUBLIC ROADS (NAMES AND DESCRIPTIONS OF HIGHWAYS) ORDER, 2023

2. An application having been made by the Chief Engineer, it is hereby ordered that names and descriptions of highways described in the Schedule hereto shall be revised.

Application for name change.

3. The highways referred to in paragraph 2 above are hereby declared to have their names and route descriptions changed as described.

SCHEDULE**[REG. 2]****PHILIP GOLDSOHN HIGHWAY**

Starting at the roundabout at the junction of Princess Margaret Drive, Freetown Road and Central American Boulevard going in a Northerly Direction towards Haulover Bridge and onwards towards Ladyville Village; passing through Sand Hill and onwards to Biscayne Village passing over Tower Hill Bridge and towards Chan Pine Ridge Junction to meet the roundabout at the intersection with the Orange Walk By-Pass; then onward to the roundabout at the intersection with the Orange Walk – San Estevan Road, then towards Buena Vista Village and onwards to meet the junction of Libertad then turning left towards Corozal Town passing through Main Street and 7th Avenue to meet Santa Rita Junction then turn right to Santa Elena at the Mexican Border.

GEORGE PRICE HIGHWAY

Starting at the intersection of Central American Boulevard and Cemetery Road going West passing through Lord's Ridge Cemetery and onwards, passing through Hattieville Village, continuing west passing through Roaring Creek Village and onwards to the roundabout in Santa Elena and continuing along the Santa Elena / San Ignacio ByPass to the roundabout at Cahal Pech, continuing West, passing through Succotz Village through Benque, passing through the by-pass and the Boulevard to the Western Border.

HUMMINGBIRD HIGHWAY

Starting at the "Y" Junction of Havana Street, Dangriga and Valley Road, going in a Westerly Direction towards Pomona Village, passing through Alta Vista, going onwards to Middlesex Village, towards Belmopan to meet the Junction of the George Price Highway at approximately Mile 48 Roaring Creek Village on the George Price Highway.

THOMAS VINCENT RAMOS HIGHWAY

Starting at the Junction of the Hummingbird Highway at approximately Mile 6, going on a Southerly Direction and passing Silk Grass Village and

onwards towards Kendall Bridge and proceeding South passing through the villages of San Roman and Santa Rosa to meet the Junction of Mango Creek Road and turning right on a South Easterly direction passing over Swasey Bridge, Bladden River Bridge, Deep River and Golden Stream Rivers, passing in front of Big Falls Village and onwards towards Big Falls Bridge to meet the Junction of San Antonio Road at the dump (Mile 14) then turning left towards Machaca Forest Station passing over Jacinto Creek Bridge and through Forest Home Settlement passing through Cattle Landing then turning right along the coastline to meet Joe Taylor Bridge.

COASTAL PLAIN HIGHWAY

Starting at the intersection near to La Democracia village, approximately Mile 29 on the George Price Highway and going on a south easterly Direction towards Sibun River Bridge and onwards crossing over Soldier Creek Bridge and proceeding to the Junction of Gales Point Road then turning right to meet the Hummingbird Highway at approximately Mile 11, where there is a roundabout in Hope Creek Village.

BURRELL BOOM ROAD

Starting at the Hattieville Roundabout, approximately Mile 15, on the George Price Highway and proceeding in a Northerly Direction, passing through Burrell Boom Village, to the Boom Bridge over Belize River ending at the intersection at approximately Mile 14 on the Philip Goldson Highway.

PHILIP GOLDSON INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT ACCESS ROAD

Starting at approximately Mile 9 on the Philip Goldson Highway, going on a south easterly direction to meet the gate of the terminal building compound of the Philip S.W. Goldson International Airport.

JOHN SMITH ROAD

Starting at the roundabout intersection, approximately 7.5 miles on the George Price Highway, and proceeding in a northerly direction to the John Smith bridge over the Belize River, for approximately 5 miles to the roundabout at the intersection with the Philip Goldson International Airport Access Road.
