2. The principal Regulations are amended in the Schedule—


(a) in section III, under the item headed “Navigational Aids”, by deleting the terms “\$1.50 per GRT (with a maximum of \$875.00)” and substituting them with the terms “\$3.00 per GRT (with a maximum of \$2,500.00)”; and

(b) in section IV, under the item headed “Port Dues”, by deleting the terms “for cruise ships \$0.30 per head” and substituting them with the terms “for cruise ships \$0.60 per head”.


