and shall be read and construed as one with the Coastal and River Passenger Trade (Fees) Regulations, which are hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations.

2. The principal Regulations are amended by repealing regulation 3 and replacing it with the following–

“Table of fees.

3. The following table of fees shall be imposed for the purposes mentioned in the said table–

Harbour Master’s Fees

For registration of all vessels \$50.00

For Certificates (Licenses) of all vessels–

Class A: up to an overall length
of 34 feet for–



- (i) private pleasure boats \$360.00
 - (ii) commercial passenger boats \$600.00
 - (iii) commercial cargo boats \$900.00
 - (iv) commercial fishing \$300.00
- Class E: commercial passenger catamaran—
- (i) 100 passengers or less \$400.00
 - (ii) 101-150 passengers \$500.00
 - (iii) 151 passengers and above \$600.00”.
