REGULATIONS made by the Minister responsible for transport in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 112 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act, Chapter 230 of the Substantive Laws of Belize, Revised Edition 2020, and all other powers thereunto him enabling.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the

MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC (SPEED MEASURING DEVICE) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2023,

and shall be read and construed as one with the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Speed Measuring Device) Regulations, which are hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations.

2. The principal Regulations are amended by inserting after regulation 1, the following new regulation–

“Interpretation. **1A.** In these Regulations–

“speed measuring device” means any speed measuring device approved by the Chief Transport Officer, pursuant to regulation 2.”.

3. The principal Regulations are amended by repealing regulation 2 and substituting it with the following–

Amendment of
regulation 2.

“Speed measuring device.

2.– (1) A speed measuring device shall be used for measuring the speed of a motor vehicle.

(2) The Chief Transport Officer shall approve the types of speed measuring devices that should be used to measure the speed of a motor vehicle.

(3) The Chief Transport Officer shall, by Notice in the *Gazette*, publish the approved types of speed measuring devices.”.

Amendment of regulation 3.

4. Regulation 3 of the principal Regulations is amended by–

- (a) deleting the words “the device specified in regulation 2” and substituting the words “an approved speed measuring device”; and
- (b) replacing the word “vehicle” with the words “motor vehicle” wherever it occurs.

Commencement.

5. These Regulations shall come into force with effect from the 1st day of March, 2024.

Negative resolution.

6. These Regulations are subject to negative resolution.
