
2. Section 2 of the principal Regulations is amended by deleting the definition of the term “sole practitioner” and replacing it with the following–

Amendment of regulation 2.

“means–

- (a) a person licensed by the Commission to conduct the business of a registered agent who does not, in the normal course of doing so, act in association with any other person to conduct business; or
- (b) a firm of not more than three attorneys or accountants;”.


