1. These Regulations may be cited as the

## TOWN COUNCILS (REGISTRATION OF ELECTORS AND ELECTIONS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2024,

and shall be read and construed as one with the Town Councils (Registration of Electors and Elections) Regulations, which, as amended, is hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations.

**2.** The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 69:01(1)–

- (a) in paragraph (e), by deleting the comma and substituting it with the term "; or";
- (b) by inserting after paragraph (e), the following new paragraph-

"(f) he is a member of the Coast Guard."; and
