and shall be read and construed as one with the Town Councils (Registration of Electors and Elections) Regulations, which, as amended, is hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations.

2. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 69:01(1)–
- Amendment  
of regulation  
69:01.
- (a) in paragraph (e), by deleting the comma and substituting it with the term “; or”;

(b) by inserting after paragraph (e), the following new paragraph–

“(f) he is a member of the Coast Guard.”; and

- (c) by repealing paragraph (d) of the proviso and replacing it with the following–

Form 15.

“(d) the application shall be in the manner set out in Form 15 and shall be signed by the voter in the presence of a Justice of the Peace, the Commissioner of Police, the Commandant of the Belize Defence Force, or the Commandant of the Coast Guard, as the occasion permits”.

Amendment of  
Schedule.

3. The principal Regulations are amended in Form 15 of the Schedule by inserting below the term “\*Commandant, Belize Defence Force”, the term “\*Commandant, Coast Guard”.

Negative  
resolution.

4. These Regulations are subject to negative resolution.
