

IMMIGRATION (VISA EXEMPTION) (THE UNITED ARAB EMIRATES) REGULATIONS, 2024.

2. It is hereby declared that in order to further develop and strengthen the friendly relations between Belize and the United Arab Emirates, the Government of Belize has concluded an agreement with the United Arab Emirates under which Belize has agreed to relax on a reciprocal basis visa restrictions on bona fide holders of diplomatic and official passports and bona fide holders of diplomatic and special passports issued by the Government of the United Arab Emirates, who will be entering Belize and staying for periods not exceeding ninety days.
