**TOWNS PROPERTY EVALUATION (COROZAL TOWN COUNCIL) (PROPERTY FEE) ORDER, 2025.**

2. The Property fee for **Corozal Town** shall be as follows–

Property fee.

- (a) in respect of unoccupied property of a value of three hundred dollars and above, 2 % of the value thereof;
- (b) in respect of unoccupied property of a value of less than three hundred dollars, the sum of one dollar;
- (c) in respect of occupied property of an annual value of thirty-five dollars and above, 5 % of the annual value thereof;
- (d) in respect of occupied property of an annual value of less than thirty-five dollars, 3 % of the annual value thereof,

Provided, however, that the sum of one dollar shall be the minimum rate payable in respect of a property or holding of real property.

**3.** The rates specified in paragraph 2 are applicable for the financial year beginning on the 1st of April 2026.
