1. <u>Central Bank of Belize (Amendment) Bill, 2025.</u>

Bill for an Act to amend the Central Bank of Belize Act, Chapter 262 of the Substantive Laws of Belize, Revised Edition 2020; to provide for the Director General of the Financial Services Commission to be a member of the Board of Directors of the Central Bank of Belize; and to provide for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.

2. **Broadcasting Bill, 2025.**

Bill for an Act to repeal and replace the Broadcasting and Television Act, Chapter 227 of the Substantive Laws of Belize, Revised Edition 2020; to further establish and facilitate a modernised framework for the licensing and regulation of broadcasters; and to provide for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.

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NOTICES OF QUESTIONS AND MOTIONS

MOTIONS

1. Official Charities Fund Motion, 2025.

(referred 12.05.25)

BE IT RESOLVED THAT this House approves the expenditure of \$2,595,089 from the Official Charities Fund as detailed in Appendix A of the Draft Estimates of Revenue and Expenditure for the year ending 31st March, 2025.

Cabinet's recommendation to be signified.

2. <u>Inter-American Development Bank – Third General Capital Increase in Authorized Capital Stock of the Inter-American Investment Corporation (IDB Invest) - Subscription Motion, 2025.</u>

(referred 12.05.25)

WHEREAS, Belize is a member of the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) (the "Bank") and the Inter-American Investment Corporation (IDB Invest), both being institutions under the IDB Group;

AND WHEREAS, the Board of Governors of the **IDB and IDB Invest** on 10th March 2024, adopted Resolution CII/AG-5/24 which approved a US\$3.5 billion general capital increase in the authorized capital stock of the Bank, to enable the Bank to support a new business model for IDB Invest to carry out its developmental purpose and functions (GCI-III) (IDB Invest +);

AND WHEREAS, in accordance with Resolution CII/AG-5/24, Belize is required to subscribe to 130 new GCI-III shares for IDB Invest, expressed in United States dollars at the rate of US\$21,000 per share, amounting to a total of US\$2,730,000.;

AND WHEREAS, payment of these shares is to be done in equal, annual installments over a period of seven (7) years, commencing 30th November, 2025, with each annual installment payment totaling US\$390,000.;

AND WHEREAS, there is no specific provision in the International Financial Organizations Act, Chapter 265 of the Laws of Belize, or any other law to enable the Minister of Finance to subscribe to such shares or make such contributions;

AND WHERERAS, consequently, the Government of Belize is desirous of obtaining the approval of the National Assembly, by way of a resolution, for the subscription and payment of Belize's additional GCI allocated shares of the IDB Invest;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that this Honourable House, being satisfied that the above-mentioned additional capital subscriptions would be beneficial to the interests of Belize in achieving better development outcomes, authorizes the Minister of Finance to sign the Instruments of Subscription, and all other related documents, and make payments before the indicated deadlines.

3. <u>Subscription to Multilateral Investment Fund IV - Inter-American Development Bank - Subscription Motion, 2025.</u>

(referred 12.05.25)

WHEREAS, Belize is a member of the Inter-American Development Bank (the "Bank") and by virtue of its membership, Belize has the right to benefit from the Bank's Multilateral Investment Fund (MIF) which was established for the purpose of supporting economic growth and poverty reduction in its member countries;

AND WHEREAS, there has been the successful establishment and implementation of MIF I, which was later replaced with MIF II and subsequently MIF III, which is currently ongoing and which was recently renewed until 12th March, 2026;

AND WHEREAS, the member countries of the Bank, in recognition of the vital role of entrepreneurial innovation in addressing development challenges, fostering opportunities for poor and vulnerable populations, catalyzing dynamic economic growth, mitigating climate change, and advancing gender equality and diversity in the Latin American and Caribbean region, agreed to the establishment of a fourth Multilateral Investment Fund (MIF IV), in the total sum of US\$400 million;

AND WHEREAS, the Board of Governors of the Bank on 10th March, 2024, adopted Resolutions AG-8/24, CII/AG-6/24, and MIF/DE-7/24), which approved the establishment of the MIF IV, which shall govern the assets and liabilities of the MIF III, and support the continuation of its activities through the purpose stated above;

AND WHEREAS, as per the norm, this replenishment of the MIF will be made up of contribution commitments by donor member countries of the Bank;

AND WHEREAS, Belize's allocated contribution to MIF IV is US\$691,699.60 to be paid in three equal annual installments of US\$230,566.53, of which the first installment will be due and payable in July 2025;

AND WHEREAS, there is no specific provision in the International Financial Organizations Act, Chapter 265 of the Laws of Belize, or any other law to enable the Minister of Finance to make such contributions;

AND WHERERAS, consequently, the Government of Belize is desirous of obtaining the approval of the National Assembly by way of a resolution before making such contributions;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that this Honourable House being satisfied that the above-mentioned contributions to MIF IV would be beneficial to the interests of Belize, authorizes the Minister of Finance to sign an Instrument of Acceptance and Contribution, and all other documents associated therewith.

5. <u>Establishment of the National Assembly Staff Committee</u> <u>Motion, 2025.</u>

(referred 12.05.25)

WHEREAS, section 3 (1) of the National Assembly Staff Act, Chapter 14, Substantive Laws of Belize, Revised Edition 2020, establishes a National Assembly Staff Committee consisting of the Speaker of the House of Representatives, or in his absence the Deputy Speaker; three Members of the House of Representatives; the President of the Senate and one other Member of the Senate nominated by the Senate; and one Member of the staff of the National Assembly or one other person who is not a Member of staff of the National Assembly, nominated by the staff of the National Assembly;

AND WHEREAS, section 3 (1) (b) of the National Assembly Staff Act, Chapter 14, Substantive Laws of Belize, Revised Edition 2020, provides that the three Members of the House of Representatives forming part of the National Assembly Staff Committee shall be nominated by the House;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Honourable House hereby nominate the Honourable Dolores Balderamos Garcia, the Honourable Rodwell Ferguson, and the Honourable Tracy Panton, to be Members of the National Assembly Staff Committee.
