2. The principal Rules are amended in rule 16(1)–

(a) by inserting after paragraph (i), the following new paragraph–

“(ia) any political party symbol, which includes any insignia, emblem, flag, seal, logo, design or name that has been used or is associated with a political party for at least ten years and that political party has fielded candidates in a General, City or Town Council Election under the Representation of the People Act,

- (b) in paragraph (j), by deleting the words “paragraphs (a) to (i)” and substituting the words “paragraphs (a) to (ia)”.
