**AN ACT to amend the People's Constitution Commission Act, Act No. 28 of 2022; to extend the time for the Prime Minister to lay before the National Assembly the report of the Commission after receipt; and to provide for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.**

*BE IT ENACTED, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Representatives and Senate of Belize and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

and shall be read and construed as one with the People's Constitution Commission Act, which, as amended, is hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

Amendment of  
section 21.

2. The principal Act is amended in section 21 as follows-
  - (i) by deleting the words “sixty days” and substituting the words “twelve months”; and
  - (ii) by inserting after the words “National Assembly”, the words “together with any response of the Government to the said report.”.
