AN ACT to amend the Trade Licensing Act, Act No. 19 of 2024; to further change the date of the entry into force of the Act to allow for further public sensitisation of the scope and nature of the Act; and to provide for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.

BE IT ENACTED, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Representatives and Senate of Belize and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the

and shall be read and construed as one with the Trade Licensing Act, which is hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

2. The principal Act is amended by repealing section 52 and replacing it with the following—

“52.—(1) This Act shall come into force on a date appointed by the Minister by Order published in the *Gazette*.

(2) An order under sub-section (1) may appoint different dates for the commencement of different provisions of this Act.”.
