I BILLS FOR SECOND READING

1. Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Amendment) Bill, 2026.

Bill for an Act to amend the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act, Chapter 230 of the Substantive Laws of Belize, Revised Edition 2020; to expand the powers of traffic wardens to include the enforcement of, and carrying out of duties under the Motor Vehicle Insurance (Third Party Risks) Act; and to provide for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.

2. Motor Vehicles Insurance (Third Party Risks) (Amendment) Bill, 2026.

Bill for an Act to amend the Motor Vehicle Insurance (Third Party Risks) Act, Chapter 231 of the Substantive Laws of Belize, Revised Edition 2020; to empower traffic wardens to require the production of insurance certificates; to increase the penalties for using a motor vehicle without insurance; and to provide for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.
