

Resolution Authorizing the Ratification by Belize of the Agreement Between Belize and the Benelux States on the Exemption from Visa Requirements for Holders of Valid Diplomatic Passports Motion, 2025.

WHEREAS, Belize signed the Agreement between Belize and the Benelux States on the exemption from visa requirements for holders of valid diplomatic passports on the 6th May 2025, in Brussels, Belgium (hereinafter “the Agreement”);

AND WHEREAS, the purpose of this Agreement is to strengthen and further develop friendly and cooperative relations among the countries;

AND WHEREAS, within the framework of this Agreement, holders of valid diplomatic passports will be exempted from visa requirements to enter the territories of any of the other Parties to the Agreement;

AND WHEREAS, the Government of Belize is desirous of ratifying the Agreement pursuant to Article 12;

AND WHEREAS, section 61(A)(2)(a) of the Belize Constitution, as amended by the Belize Constitution (Sixth Amendment) Act (No. 13 of 2008), provides that the Senate shall authorize the ratification of any treaty by the Government of Belize;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Senate authorizes the Government of Belize to ratify the Agreement between the Belize and the Benelux States on the exemption of visa requirements for holders of valid diplomatic passports, a copy of which is hereto annexed.
