2. The principal Regulations are amended by inserting, after regulation 73, the following new regulation 73A–


“Customs clearance fee on foreign parcels.

**73A.**–(1) There shall be charged and paid, on every foreign parcel despatched to the United States of America, a customs clearance fee of one dollar per foreign parcel.

(2) The customs clearance fee shall be payable by the sender at the time of posting of the foreign parcel.

(3) The customs clearance fee shall apply regardless of the weight or dimensions of the foreign parcel.”.
